Civil Service National Angling Championship

Friday 22nd September 2017 at Puddleduck Farm Fishery, St Mary's Lane, Upminster, RM14 3NX

The venue for 2017 is the snake lake at Puddleduck Farm near Upminster in Essex. The has a total of 100 pegs and the 'usual' press-ganged volunteers from chosen pegs will do the weigh in. The National was fished here in 2013 & 2015.

Directions –

From J29 northbound on the M25 take the east bound A127, after approx. ¾ mile turn right on to the B186 After approx 1 mile the road turns sharp right and becomes the B187. The fishery is on your left.

On the day –

The draw will be as you arrive with fishing between 10:00 and 16:00.

Should you have a disability, please let me know. If you are aware of anyone who has expired please let me know on 01424 224202. After 10 years it is possible that someone has passed on.

The **peg fee is £8**, including overheads. **A refund will be payable to those who paid £8.50.** Should you win but did not enter the main pool then you will only receive the non-returnable trophy, which is being replaced this year.

Main Pool (Optional £8)

This will be paid out on the top 6 individual weights as follows – 1st – 30%, 2nd – 22.5%, 3rd – 17.5%, 4th – 12.5%, 5th – 10%, and 6th – 7.5%.

Those who qualify for a main pool pay-out **will not** be eligible to receive a section win; this will default to the angler with the next highest weight in the section. **Only section wins are in cash.**

Section Pool (Optional £3)

Sections will be 10 anglers. Any odd numbers will be added to each section and the pool increased pro-rata (ie 11 would then be a pool of £33)

The event is an invitation by email this year, thanks to my wife's computer so please ensure that you have given your email address.
